## QUITO & GUAYAQUIL AIRPORT

- Free shuttle service in connection with GO cruises. Pick up time from hotels to airport: approx. 3 hours before the flight, from/to specific hotels in Quito and Guayaquil. Reservation is required.
- Quito: Patio Andaluz, Mama Cuchara, Mercure, Marriott, Swissotel, Dann Carlton.
- Guayaquil: Palace, Grand Hotel, Wyndham, Oro Verde, Hilton Colon.
- Pick-up items will be reconfirmed at the hotel the night before the departure.
- GO is not responsible if the passenger misses the shuttle, flight or cruise for failing to show up on time. Arrive at the airport al least 90 min before the flight. - The cruise documentation will be delivered on the way to the airport.

- **Air ticket from Quito or Guayaquil to Galapagos:** \$495 per adult, \$375 per child under 12, issued by GO in connection with cruise schedules, prearranging and assuring logistics, luggage and passengers transfers from airports to port - ship and back, documentation to Galapagos\*.
  - **Galapagos Entrance Fee:** \$100 adult, \$50 children under 12, to be paid in cash upon arrival in Galapagos. If requested this tax can be invoiced by GO.
  - **CGG Migration Control Card:** \$20 per person.
- Tips, medical services, travel insurance and others not specified.

### Supplements & Discounts:

- **Single accommodation:** 50% supplement (75% on holiday season). Limited spaces. To guarantee a specific type of cabin in High Occupancy Departures 75% supplement. 2\*)
- **Triple accommodation:** 25% discount for the third person sharing cabin with two full-fare paying guests.
- **Accommodation for children** under 12 years of age:
